

Levelling up Fund – January 2023

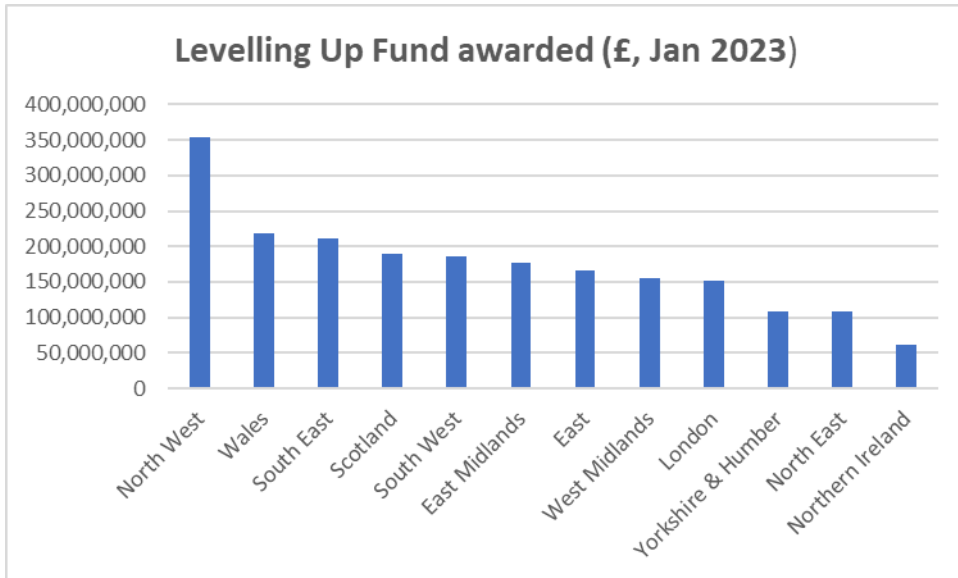
Analysing the regional allocations of the levelling up fund, the North East is also losing out in other areas as well:

The North East secured 5.20% of the pot - £108,548,482 out of the £2,086,400,298 allocated under this round of the levelling up fund – only Northern Ireland received less. And the North West received more than three times the levelling-up fund as the North East.

Six North East organisations received the funding: 4 local authorities: Gateshead, Hartlepool, Northumberland, Redcar and Cleveland, and both combined authorities.
